Connecticut College/Tufts Graduate School of Arts and Sciences Combined Degree in Museum Education (BA/MA)

The Connecticut College/Tufts Graduate School of Arts and Sciences Combined Degree in Museum Education (BA/MA) offers undergraduate Connecticut College students who successfully complete the Museum Studies Certificate Program, an accelerated path to earn their master's degree in Museum Education from Tufts University.

With faculty approval, accepted students can apply two courses in Museum Studies taken at Connecticut College to complete their undergraduate degree towards Tufts' MA in Museum Education. The MA degree can typically be completed in less than a year and a half. Students must graduate from Connecticut College before matriculating into the graduate program at Tufts.

- Connecticut College students who are interested in applying to the Tufts Museum Masters Program may apply during the spring of their junior or senior year.
- Tufts GSAS will waive the application fee to the Tufts Museum Masters Program.
- Tufts GSAS will waive the GRE scores for the Tufts Museum Masters Program.
- All admitted students to the Tufts Museum Masters Program are eligible for a one-time \$10,000 adjustment to their tuition requirements to account for the successful transfer of two pre-approved courses from Connecticut College to Tufts University.
- For admitted students from Connecticut College, Tufts GSAS will take reasonable efforts (though not a guarantee) to match the financial aid package provided by Connecticut College for their undergraduate education.
- All admitted students shall remain enrolled at Connecticut College until the bachelor's degree is conferred by Connecticut College. Once the bachelor's degree is conferred, the students will matriculate as Tufts graduate students in the Tufts Museum Masters Program pursuant to Tufts GSAS policies.
